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World Rowing Cup Series

The World Rowing Cup is Rowing's showcase annual series, bringing together the world's elite athletes and global fans for a series of weekend regattas that blend thrilling racing with a vibrant, festival-style atmosphere.

Across 14 Olympic boat classes, nations earn points at each regatta, with the coveted World Rowing Cup title awarded to those with the highest overall total - celebrating excellence, consistency, and national pride on the international stage.

World Rowing Championships European Rowing Championships

The world's pinnacle Classic Rowing regatta, the World Rowing Championships gather 1'100 of the globe's best athletes from 70+ nations. Staged across eight days and 23 boat classes – 8 men's, 8 women's, 2 mixed, and 5 para-sport, the event crowns World Champions and consistently produces the sport's defining moments.

In pre-Olympic years, the World Rowing Championships also serve as a key Olympic qualification regatta, intensifying the drama on Rowing's most prestigious annual stage.

The European Rowing Championships is the continents' showcase regatta welcoming approximately 600 athletes from 34 nations for four days of elite racing across 23 boat classes. With roots dating back to 1893, the regatta continues to produce Europe's signature Rowing memories.

The flagship of Rowing's adventure format, the World Rowing Beach Sprint Finals bring the world's top Coastal Rowers together for a weekend of explosive, head-to-head racing.

Beach starts, sharp buoy turns, and dramatic shore sprints create a modern spectacle – amplified by festival energy and striking seaside backdrops that showcase Rowing's future-forward evolution and global reach.

Beach Sprint will make its Olympic debut at LA28.
